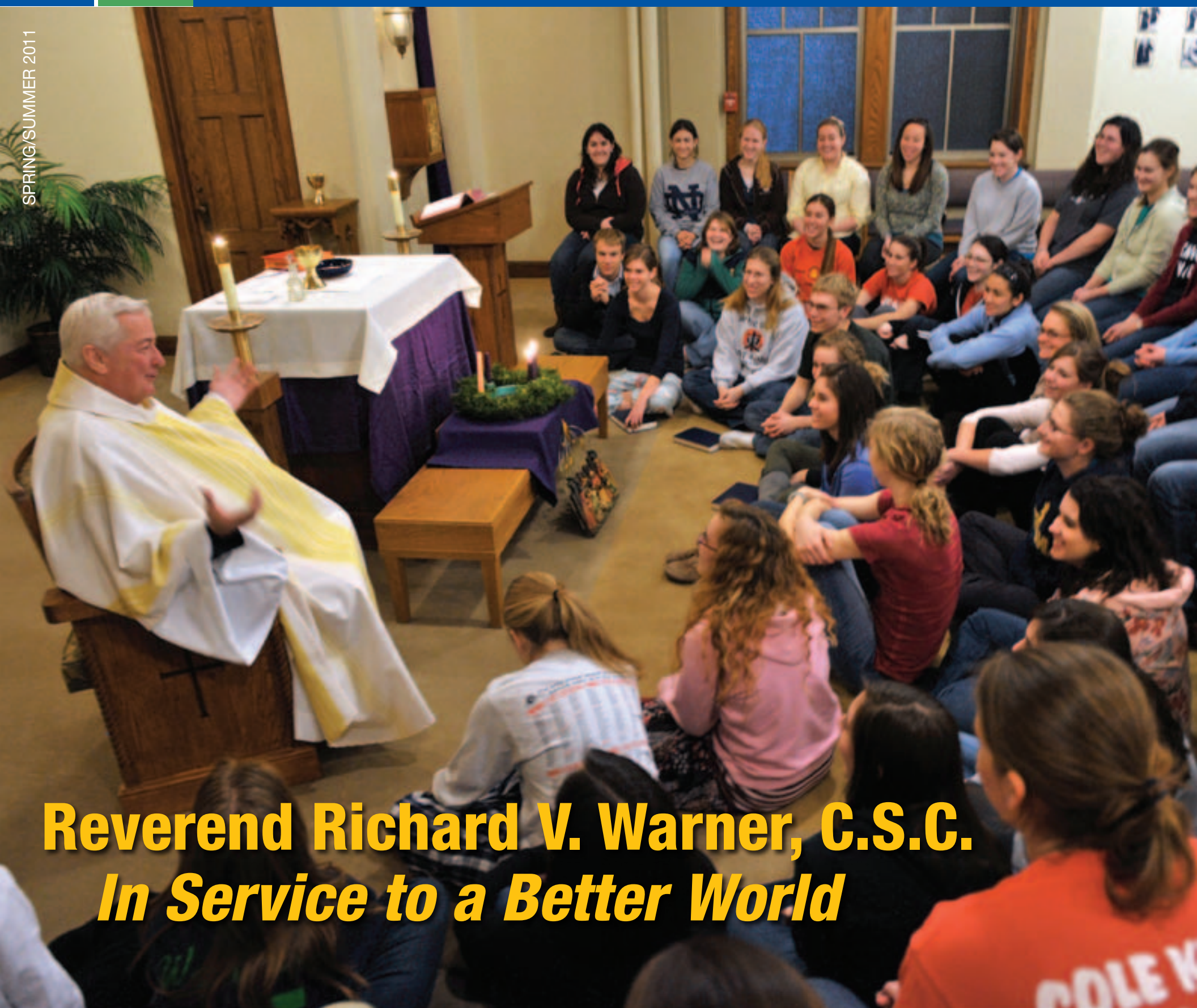

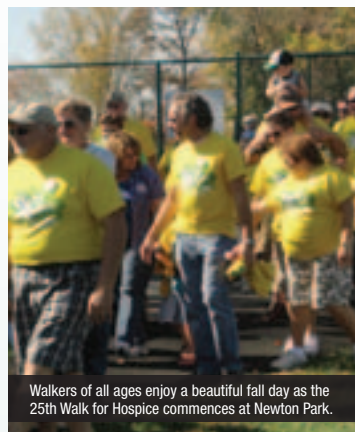

children, Michael and Donna, and together their team collected over \$1,000 in donations from all across the United States.

The Gangloffs, Tammi and Ted, used the Hospice Foundation's new online fundraising tool to raise money for hospice care. This is what Ted wrote on his fundraising page:

“On November 29, 2008 I lost my dad to cancer. This was an extremely difficult time for Dad and our family. The help we received from the Center for Hospice Care was a blessing. They taught us what to expect as the cancer progressed and how to administer pain medications. They sent a nurse for check ups and gave phone support 24/7 so Dad could stay at home where he was surrounded by his family. God bless their volunteers and staff. They sent a volunteer to sit with Dad so Mom could do the needed shopping. For a short time the 24 hour a day care that Dad needed got to be overwhelming for us so we used the Hospice House where Dad was cared for by doctors and staff around the clock. To me this is a priceless service offered by a not-for-profit organization. I'm glad to help raise money for the Center for Hospice Care. On October 10th we will join the Walk for Hospice and I'm asking you to make a donation. Thank you! ”

The Gangloffs raised nearly \$1,000 using the Internet to become our largest online fundraising team.

Walkers Cheryl and Denny Correll experienced hospice care with Cheryl's mom, Betty Ebner. They explained that among the many benefits was the fact that Betty was able to spend every minute with her favorite side-kick, Precious, who was with her to the very end.

Fundraising dollars raised in this event enable Center for Hospice Care (CHC) to continue to provide physicians, nurses, social workers, spiritual care counselors, home health aides and trained community volunteers to improve the quality of living for our patients and families facing progressive, life-limiting illnesses. CHC also provides grief counseling, art therapy, a children's grief camp and community education free of charge to hundreds of people each week in our community. Because of the commitment of everyone involved in this 25th Anniversary event, a total of \$43,283.53 was raised to provide support to CHC patients and their families!

Foundation CEO Elected National Board Chairman

Mark Murray, President/CEO of Center for Hospice Care (CHC) and the Hospice Foundation, was recently elected to a two-year term as Chairman of the Board of Directors for the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization (NHPCO), and officially took office on January 1, 2011.

According to Murray, "Our hospice program has always shared the NHPCO mission of helping individuals and families facing serious illness, death and grief to experience the best that humankind can offer."

With 52,000 members, including 3,700 hospice and palliative care provider members, NHPCO is the oldest and largest membership organization representing hospice and palliative care programs and professionals in the United States. NHPCO members care for over 90% of the nation's more than 1.6 million hospice patients.

Murray has served on the 24-member national board since 2006 when he was first elected as the Great Lakes Geographic Area Director representing the interests of the 589 hospice program members in a six state region. He previously served in the office of Secretary and has been a member of the NHPCO Executive Committee for the past three years.

"For more than 30 years NHPCO has led the efforts to mobilize social change for improved care at the end of life, not just in the United States, but in places around the world," says Murray. "After working at a member hospice program for the last 21 years, it's an honor to be elected NHPCO Chairman of the Board."

In his role as Board Chairman, Murray also serves on the boards of various NHPCO affiliate organizations, including: Hospice

Action Network, a Washington, DC political advocacy organization; FHSSA, formerly known as the Foundation for Hospices of Sub-Saharan Africa; and the National Hospice Foundation, where he served in the office of Treasurer during 2010. NHPCO and its affiliates are based at the new National Center for Care at the End of Life in Alexandria, VA.

A former Chairman of the Board of the Indiana Hospice and Palliative Care Organization, Murray continues to serve on that Board and chairs its Public Awareness Committee. He also serves as a member of the Indiana Home Health and Hospice Services Council since being appointed to that post by Governor Mitch Daniels in 2006.

Murray has served as President/CEO of the Center for Hospice Care since 1997, following seven years as Vice President.



CHC Opens Area's First Palliative Care Center



The Center for Hospice Care has expanded its palliative care services into the community with the recent opening of its outpatient Palliative Care Center, located

at 4220 Edison Lakes Parkway in Mishawaka. The first of its kind in north central Indiana, it offers patients and families an opportunity to receive the physical, emotional and spiritual support necessary to improve the quality of living.

People who learn that they are very ill, as well as those living with chronic pain, frequently become depressed. As a result, according to a study recently published in The New England Journal of Medicine, this state of mind serves to reduce life expectancy. Patients whose pain is treated often sleep better, eat better and communicate more with relatives.

Patient- and family-centered palliative care optimizes quality of life by anticipating, preventing and treating suffering. Palliative care is not limited to care for the terminally ill or dying. Anyone with a serious, life-limiting or chronic illness can benefit from palliative care, which can extend from a few hours to several years.

There is often confusion between palliative

care and hospice care. The most significant difference is that palliative care patients may simultaneously pursue active curative treatment. Palliative care includes aggressive symptom management as well as emotional support and assistance.

Palliative care referrals may be made by any physician, preferably at an early stage of treatment. Once a referral is made, an appointment is scheduled with one of the agency's medical directors who will examine the patient and then provide a consultation to discuss the options for care.

Once a treatment plan is prescribed, the patient is served by an interdisciplinary team, which is comprised of a board certified palliative care physician, a registered nurse, a social worker, physical



therapist, spiritual counselor, dietician and a home health aide. This team then collaborates to determine how best to address the patient's needs for comfort care and support.

Did You Know?

With more than 85 hospice programs operating in the state, Center for Hospice Care continues to be "Indiana's Most Chosen Hospice Program." Here are some facts about our organization and services.

- The total number of patients served from 1980-2010 is 20,743.
- More than half of the total number of patients served were admitted in the last seven years; 25% were served in the past three years.
- The total number of patients served in 2010 was 1,774.
- Center for Hospice Care's average daily census in 2010 was 346, up 10% from 2009.
- The value of charity care, write offs and adjustments in 2010 was \$1,004,102.
- The "We Believe Fund," an employee giving fund, raised more than \$9,000 in 2010 to help patients with needs that go beyond the scope of regular CHC funds.
- The Ugandan Impact Fund, another employee giving fund supporting palliative care in Uganda, raised more than \$8,000 in 2010.

FHSSA Partnerships Make a Difference in the Lives of the Dying Throughout Africa



The facts are overwhelming. Every day, nearly 7,000 people die from HIV/AIDS in sub-Saharan Africa. More than 35 million women, children and men in this region have already died of AIDS. FHSSA is working to ensure the dying and their families find compassion and relief from suffering at the end of life.

Through FHSSA's innovative Partnership Initiative more than 52,000 patients received quality care and services in 2008 by linking African hospices and palliative care providers with American hospices and organizations. Currently, FHSSA has 90 active partnerships in 16 countries and 27 states in the U.S. – and these partners touch thousands of lives. These accomplishments prove that there is great strength when many individuals work together. While FHSSA is launching new partnerships on an ongoing basis, there are more than 100 African hospices waiting for a U.S. partner. Only with the support and involvement of individuals and organizations will FHSSA help meet this need.

Worldwide attention and funding in response to the AIDS pandemic is focused on many necessary areas such as vaccine development, prevention and anti-retroviral medication availability. Yet, little attention is being paid to the care and support of the dying and

their families. This is a central focus for FHSSA in advancing its Partnership Initiative and the National Hospice Foundation (NHF) is working to raise support that FHSSA desperately needs to continue its mission of building partnerships to enhance compassionate care in Africa.

In 2008, Center for Hospice Care (CHC) was selected to partner with the Palliative Care Association of Uganda (PCAU). Since that time, CHC staff have made two visits to Uganda and Rose Kiwanuka, PCAU's National Coordinator, has visited the CHC's programs. Through a grassroots effort, CHC employees established an employee giving program that provides more than \$8,000 in annual support for PCAU. These funds, when combined with a grant from the Hospice Foundation, enabled PCAU to move from a borrowed one room office at the African Palliative Care Association to its own building and compound in February 2010.

CHC Staff Improving the Quality of Living in Uganda

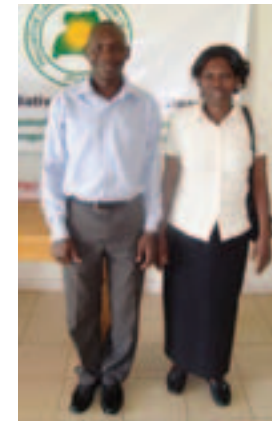
Little did Rose Kiwanuka realize the impact she would have on staff at Center for Hospice Care (CHC) when she visited the South Bend area for two weeks in the fall of 2009. As the National Coordinator for the Palliative Care Association of Uganda (PCAU), Rose was in town to learn about the American approach to hospice care and to share the work of PCAU in its efforts to bring, as Rose describes it, "culturally appropriate palliative care to all Ugandans."

From her visit, CHC's Uganda Impact Fund was born. In its first year in existence, this staff giving program raised more than \$8,000 through direct gifts and voluntary bi-weekly payroll deductions from more than

50 participating CHC staff members. In addition, more than \$3,000 was raised from various community supporters during her visit.

With these gifts, along with a grant from the Hospice Foundation, and through funds raised from a staff-funded silent auction, PCAU was able to fund two mission-critical initiatives that would otherwise not have been possible: the leasing of a new home for PCAU (pictured above), which is located in a safe and secure gated compound in the nation's capital, Kampala; and two fully funded scholarships for students to complete the Clinical Palliative Care Course (CPCC) at Hospice Africa Uganda.

Clinical Palliative Care Students



Staff of the Center for Hospice Care (CHC) supported two students to undertake the Clinical Palliative Care Course (CPCC) through its Uganda Impact Fund, a fund which was started by CHC staff members in late 2009. The fund's purpose is to provide financial support to the Palliative Care Association of Uganda (PCAU) as it works to expand its outreach to

provide palliative care provision to remote districts of the country.

As a result of their generosity, staff giving to the Uganda Impact Fund totaled \$8,008.50 in 2010 alone, which resulted in PCAU's ability to fund the students to complete the nine-month Clinical Palliative Care Course (CPCC), which is offered by Hospice Africa Uganda at a cost of \$3,750 USD each. Those students have now both graduated and returned to their places of work to assume leadership roles in the delivery of palliative care in their districts. The new CHC-supported graduates are:

Mr. Steven Nyakojo Abetegeka was a Clinical Officer from Kibaale district. As a result of his successful program completion, his title has now changed to Clinical Palliative Care Officer in charge of Kibaale Health Center III. As the result his graduation from Uganda's program, he is now a recognized prescriber of morphine, the drug of choice for pain control. Health care workers who identify patients with palliative care needs will now be able to refer the patients to him for treatment.

Ms. Clare Muhumuza has successfully completed Uganda's program and returned to her district, the Mubende district, as well. Now that she holds the CPCC Diploma, she too is a recognized prescriber of morphine and has been placed in the district hospital and charged with the development of the hospital's palliative care provision. In fact, she will be responsible for spearheading and supporting palliative care service provision throughout the entire Mubende district.

Hanna O'Brien: Volunteering in Uganda



Tell us about yourself... Who is Hanna O'Brien?

I am a junior at Notre Dame. I come from a small town west of Chicago, called Wrenville. I love to volunteer, read books and learn, and I have been told I have a great sense of humor.

What is your major field of study at Notre Dame?

I am a College of Science Pre-Professional Studies and Anthropology double major. I aspire to become a doctor, and bring health care to a third-world marginal community, so I may also study and learn from that culture.

How did you first learn about PCAU?

Notre Dame's Africa Faith and Justice Network and the Ford Family Program sponsored a discussion with PCAU's National Coordinator, Rose Kiwanuka. Before this talk, I had never even heard of palliative care!

Why was this type of an internship opportunity appealing to you?

Experiencing Ugandan palliative care provided me a unique opportunity for an educational and personal curiosity: understanding the relationship of Western medicine with African culture. It allowed me to learn about the culture's interpretation of Western medical practices in palliative care, and how it cooperates with traditional healing. In palliative care, the patient's and the patient's family's understanding of death is of great importance, in addition to a unique holistic approach of addressing all social, spiritual, and psychological issues.

Describe some of the activities in which you were involved during your internship.

At Hospice Africa Uganda and Hospice Jinja, I observed staff routines, went on home visits, discussed with staff members about their catchment conditions, and interacted with the adult and child patients at the weekly daycare. Interacting with the children at the Cancer Institute Children's Ward at Kampala's Mulago Hospital, I learned how palliative care varies for children and how the patient's family handles the stress of having a sick, young child. In Buyijja Forest, I observed the traditional healing school, Prometra Uganda.

Who was the most interesting (or intriguing) person you met in Uganda? What made him/her memorable?

At Hospice daycare, I bonded with a young, female patient born HIV-positive. When her mother died from HIV, her step-mother kicked her out of the house. Destitute and ill,

but incredibly courageous and independent, this young girl reminded me of all the Ugandan children who are forced to grow up too early. Meeting her exposed me to the strength of these children and the struggles they face.

What was the most interesting place you visited?

The first place I think of when I reflect on my trip is my family's home in Makindye. My family and all the neighbors were amazing, welcoming people who took great care of me and really helped me learn more intimately about Uganda, its family dynamics, and its culture.

What was the biggest surprise or aha! that you encountered?

The biggest "aha!" for me came when I realized the sheer devotion of the hospice staffs to providing the best holistic care for each patient. The health care workers are so committed to learning from one another and others in order to improve their clinical practices. They do an amazing job at communicating to discuss each patient's situations and allowing all to consult and assist.

Did the experience live up to your expectations?

To be honest, I prepared myself for Uganda by trying to clear my mind and heart of all expectations. Of the basic expectations I did have, my experience was way beyond and above what I expected. I met so many inspiring people, and we have so much to learn from Ugandans!

What was the biggest lesson you learned as the result of this experience?

I learned not to take anything for granted – from access to clean water to the opportunity for formal education. I also learned something much deeper than that; that you cannot allow cultural predispositions to cloud your understanding of what is important to a culture different from your own. This came not from judgment of lifestyle, but a realization, from families living in extreme poverty and suffering, of how to find pure joy in living simply.

What do you plan to do now that you have returned, and will you go back to Uganda?

I will be assisting Notre Dame in making my field project with PCAU a permanent summer internship for future undergraduates! I also hope to fundraise for the organizations through student club, Global Health, ND. This trip inspired me so much that I plan to pursue palliative care in my future.

Join Us for the Midwest's Premier Cycling Event

The third annual Bike Michiana for Hospice ride will take place on September 11th at St. Patrick's County Park. Voted "Best SAG Stops" for a cycling event, this year's edition features scenic routes through country roads - and a course for everyone.



Proceeds from the event registration fee benefit The Hospice Foundation and Bike Michiana Coalition. Riders can also go the extra mile to support The Hospice Foundation by asking family and friends to pledge their support for every mile ridden either individually or with a team. The registration fee is \$30 until August 31, \$40 beginning September 1. Riders 12 and younger ride for free. Helmets are required for all riders.

At each of the four themed SAG (support and gear) stops along the way, riders will enjoy delicious food and drinks from some of the area's leading restaurants

including Fiddler's Hearth, Grande Mere Inn, Indulgence Pastry Shop & Cafe, LaSalle Grill, and Yesterday's, along with live music. The post-ride party at the finish line will have pulled pork, live music and a beer tent.

Courses for this year's event vary from a leisurely 3.5 - 11.5 mile family ride (riders choose), to longer routes of 25 miles, 40 miles, 100K (62 miles), 100 miles and even a 200K (124 mile) ride. Check in and registration begin at 7:00 a.m. Suggested group start times begin at 8 a.m. for the longer rides; the suggested start time for the family ride is 10:30 a.m.

In Service to a Better World

Father Richard Warner is one of those rare individuals whose presence fills those around him with serenity, peace and the belief that all things are possible. He is a person who inspires others to become better, who makes a powerful and positive difference through his actions, and in doing so leaves a lasting impact on each life he touches.

His endless, selfless devotion to the Catholic Church, the University of Notre Dame and the Congregation of the Holy Cross reflects his commitment to their worthy and humanitarian ideals. Described by others as a passionate, tireless, loyal leader, he has led a life of service.

After graduating from Notre Dame in 1962, Fr. Warner studied theology at Catholic University in Santiago, Chile, where he obtained his licentiate degree in 1966. Later that year he was ordained in Lakewood, Ohio.

From 1967 to 1973 he taught English and theology at St. George's College, one of the premier educational institutions in Chile, where he also served in the administration. In 1973 he became the provincial treasurer and member of the Provincial Council for the Indiana Province of the Congregation and was subsequently elected provincial superior in 1979, serving in that office for nine years.

For the next 21 years, Fr. Warner was Director of Campus Ministry at the University of Notre Dame, which promotes, encourages and engages all aspects of faith life on campus. He also served as Counselor to former Notre Dame president, Fr. Edward Malloy, C.S.C.

In 2010 Fr. Warner was elected Superior General of the Congregation of the Holy Cross and has assumed leadership for the congregation and its work throughout the world from its headquarters in Rome. He is a Corporate Member of Holy Cross Family Ministries, and received an honorary doctorate of law degree from Notre Dame in 1987.

His service beyond the congregation and university is notable as well. Fr. Warner is past Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Center for the Homeless and Memorial Health System.

Whether in Rome, in Chile or in South Bend, Fr. Warner's caring, compassionate influence has made the world a better place and continues on through those he has inspired.



2011 Helping Hands Dinner Honoring Rev. Richard V. Warner, C.S.C.

More than 375 guests gathered at the Hilton Garden Inn on May 4th to honor Rev. Richard V. Warner, C.S.C., this year's Helping Hands Award recipient, at the 27th annual event.

Co-chairs Phil and Mary Newbold began the evening by recognizing the many contributions Father Warner has to made to not only the local community but around the world.

Hospice Foundation President/CEO, Mark Murray, noted that, "back in 1980, we made a pledge to this community that no person who was eligible and desired hospice services would be turned away due to an inability to pay. 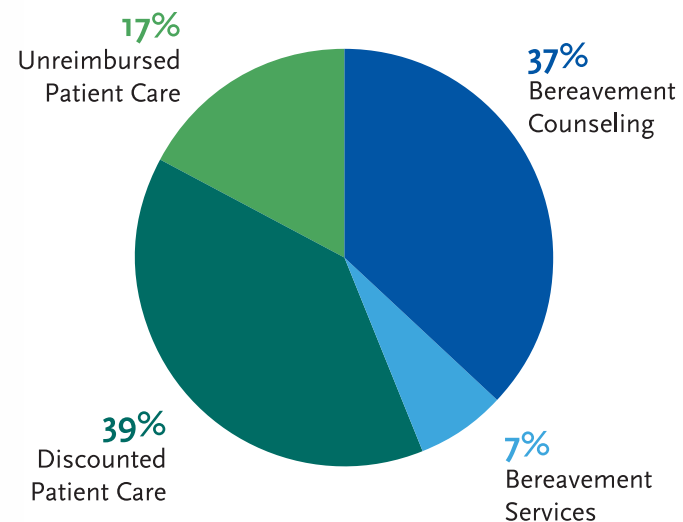
