37th Helping Hands Award Dinner

The 37th Helping Hands Award Dinner was held on Wednesday, May 4, 2022, at South Bend's Hilton Garden Inn. The honoree was community organizer, Gladys Muhammad. The theme, "Serving the Community," recognized the significant contributions her work at the South Bend Heritage Foundation and as a volunteer with numerous organizations has made to improve the quality of living in our community.

Her acceptance speech had the room enthralled as she spoke about her family, her work, her faith and her initial reluctance to accept the award. "When I went to the hospice building in Mishawaka... I went and I looked at that wall [of Helping Hand Award recipients]... I kept looking at the wall and I saw Dr. Chamblee and his wife. And I felt good because they

were Black and I'm Black. And I said, 'you sure you want me on that wall?' And they said 'yes'... I began to get excited because I'm doing it for us, for all of us, for us who grew up on the Lake... the Lake was the city dump, and nobody would have thought that us people that came off that lake would grow up and make a difference in our community. So I said yes, because I want somebody to see my Black face on that wall because it represents all of us who work hard, all day and all night trying to get some results."

She also thanked Center for Hospice Care for "being that helping hand" and noted "hospice helps us leave here in a peaceful way," as she shared the story of how CHC took care of both her husband and father at the end of their lives.

After two years of hosting virtual Gardens of Remembrance and Renewal ceremonies, we welcomed guests back to Center for Hospice Care's (CHC) Elkhart campus for an in-person event on June 7. Attendees were greeted by a beautiful spring day with sun shining upon the items that they had gathered to see dedicated.

This is a special event for families and friends because it gives them an opportunity to honor or memorialize their loved one in a tangible way with bricks and or flowering or evergreen trees. Guests were welcomed by Hospice Foundation's Chief Development Officer Chris Taelman, followed by comments from CHC President and CEO Mark Murray. Bereavement Counselor Debra Bledsoe

then led those in attendance in a response litany that helps them remember that their loved ones are always present in their lives and memories.

This year 10 trees and 19 bricks were donated in memory or honor of loved ones. The purchase of these items helps CHC keep its over 42-year promise that no one eligible for hospice care will be turned away, regardless of their ability to pay. The annual event takes place on the first Tuesday in June on the grounds of CHC's Elkhart campus. Veterans Tribute Ceremony

Hospice Foundation held their Veterans Tribute Ceremony on Tuesday, October 11. This annual event is an opportunity to dedicate items donated in memory or honor of a veteran at the Captain Robert J. Hiler Jr. Veterans Memorial, located on the grounds of Center for Hospice Care's (CHC) Mishawaka Campus. Seven plaques and 11 bricks were dedicated this year. Unfortunately, due to weather, the event was moved indoors, but many attendees braved the rain to see their items in place at the memorial.

This year's ceremony featured US Army veteran and Gold Star Mother Shelly Tropp. Shelly spoke about her time in the Army and learning to love her country. She also brought light to a serious issue facing our armed forces – active-duty soldiers and

veterans committing suicide. She spoke of her personal experience with this as her son took his life in 2015. She closed her comments with the following anonymous quote: "Our flag does not fly because the wind moves it. It flies with the last breath of each soldier who died protecting it."

Following her talk, Shelly presented quilts – made by the Niles Piecemakers Quilting Guild and given to the Michigan American Gold Star Mothers – to veterans Don Neely and Norm Woollet, two Center for Hospice Care volunteers.

After the presentation, CHC chaplain Wyatt Smith read aloud the name, rank and branch of service for each veteran who had an item dedicated in their name.

Following the dedication ceremony attendees were invited to a reception where a Missing Man Table was set in honor of our prisoners of war and missing comrades; it is decorated with special symbols to help us remember them. Milton Village Donors Gather to Tour New Facility

Hospice Foundation and REAL Services hosted an open house for Milton Village donors on Tuesday, September 13 at the Village's new home, formerly Center for Hospice Care's (CHC) inpatient unit and offices. Located in Roseland, the facility now houses Milton Adult Day Services. More than 70 people who attended the event toured the new facility, learned more about the programming offered there and enjoyed refreshments and hors d'oeuvres.

New construction associated with the remodeling involved creating the Tire Rack Garage. During the event, it contained a 1962 Studebaker Lark convertible on display thanks to Terry Rodino, a past CHC board member. Clients of Milton Adult Day Services will soon be able to tinker with a donated vehicle that will be placed in the garage.

Other features of the new dementia daytime care facility include a putting green for those who golf. It is in a safe, fenced-in outdoor space which also features a gazebo and raised garden beds.

Inside the facility, both clients and caregivers can relax in a four-season room named Jane's Front Porch. Funding for the room was provided by Mary Jane Stanley in memory of her mother, Jane Kuzmitz.

Milton Village, the new home of Milton Adult Day Services, a service of CHC, is one of the first dementia daytime care facilities in the US that integrates immersion programming into its services, which reflects best practices for dementia clients. It provides a structured setting for functionally impaired adults who require supervision and need health, social and support services during the day.



Okuyamba Fest

The event that celebrates Center for Hospice Care and Hospice Foundation's partnership with the Palliative Care Association of Uganda (PCAU), Okuyamba Fest, returned on October 27 for the first time since 2018. The event coincides with PCAU's exchange visit to the United States so that we can share a night of celebration, Ugandan food, crafts and culture with our partners. Our exchange visits had been on hiatus since the COVID-19 pandemic hit in 2020.

Mark Mwesiga, country director, and Joyce Zalwango, capacity building officer, made the journey from Uganda to Indiana for a three-week visit in October/November. Okuyamba Fest allowed them to meet with supporters in the community and talk about the important work they do to reach people in need of palliative care across Uganda. The event featured entertainment by local group Uzima! Drum and Dance as well as delicious

food and a silent auction of a variety of Ugandan arts and crafts.

While Okuyamba Fest is a celebration of our partnership with PCAU, it also helps raise funds to support PCAU's work. Money raised from Okuyamba Fest will go toward the purchase of a new vehicle for PCAU. Their work to reach all in need with palliative care takes them across the country and a sturdy and reliable vehicle is one of the most valuable tools PCAU needs to help realize their vision. Their current vehicle is over 12 years old and has travelled more than 270,000 miles! To continue increasing access to palliative care across Uganda, they need a reliable vehicle capable of traversing the rugged landscape of the outlying districts. 38th Helping Hands Award Dinner to Honor Mary and Phil Newbold

The 38th Helping Hands Award Dinner will be held on Wednesday, May 3 at Hilton Garden Inn in South Bend. We are excited to announce that the 2023 honorees are Mary and Phil Newbold. Chairing this year's dinner committee are Carmi and Chris Murphy.

Since 1985, the Helping Hands Award has honored individuals, groups and families who demonstrate civic and charitable stewardship to improve the quality of living in the communities Center for Hospice Care serves. The award recognizes the recipients for exhibiting exceptional generosity, outstanding community achievements, direct financial support or by motivating others to give.

The Newbolds were selected for the 2023 award because of their significant contributions to the health of our community. Phil served as CEO of Beacon Health System for 30 years, retiring in 2017. Under his leadership Beacon became the first Indiana hospital to join the Mayo Clinic Care Network which allows local physicians to collaborate with Mayo specialists. In addition, Beacon Children's Hospital and Elkhart General

Hospital both completed extensive expansions. Memorial Hospital became the region's only designated Level II Trauma Center during his tenure as well. Mary has served on Center for Hospice Care and Hospice Foundation boards, most recently as chair of the Hospice Foundation board.

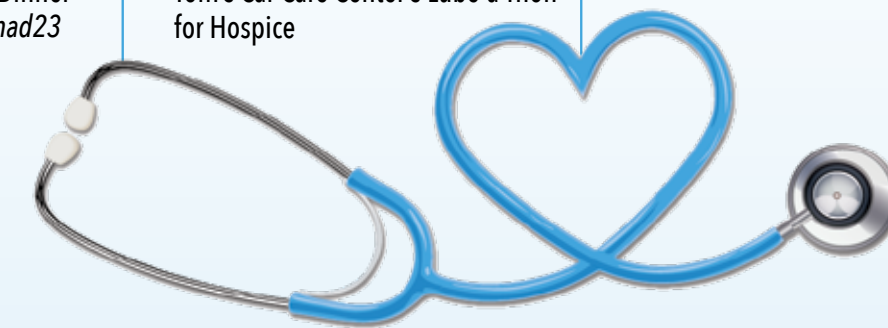

HOSPICE PARTNERSHIPS AROUND THE GLOBE

PCAU Exchange Visit to CHC/HF

Center for Hospice Care and Hospice Foundation (CHC/HF) hosted the Palliative Care Association of Uganda (PCAU) on an exchange visit from October 24th through November 12th. Exchange visits are an important aspect of our partnership work; they provide an opportunity to learn and share and facilitate a deeper relationship. Connecting in-person has been a vital aspect in building this strong partnership and has offered staff numerous ways to get directly involved.

Hosting our partners helps promote awareness for hospice and palliative care and allows us to explore new relationships and collaborations in the community, and to engage in strategic planning. PCAU's last visit was in 2018 when we celebrated 10 years of partnership. Normally a team from PCAU visits every two years, but these visits have been on hiatus since the emergence of COVID-19. Because of the unique, strong bond we have with staff at PCAU, we were able to stay in touch virtually. But there is nothing quite like an in-person meeting and conversation to catalyze our engagement.

CHC/HF hosted Mark Mwesiga, PCAU's country director, who has steered the organization successfully through these unprecedented and financially difficult times. In addition to the challenges of the pandemic, the global palliative care field has seen several long-standing funders of international hospice and palliative care reduce or even eliminate financial support across Africa. Mark has brought strategic vision and leadership to his role to navigate these challenges and bring PCAU to the national spotlight as a leader in palliative care.

Joining Mark on this visit was Joyce Zalwango, PCAU's capacity building officer, who is responsible for coordinating activities aimed at strengthening the development of palliative care work in Uganda. She works closely with Mark in advocating for palliative care and providing general support to all PCAU programs. This was Joyce's first visit to the United States, and she couldn't hide her excitement during her stay. She was eager to meet staff in person, visit new places and try new foods! While meeting with a group in the community,

she told them "getting a US visa is like a miracle. When I got the visa, I was excited and while the many stopover checks I encountered on my way worried me, somehow I trusted I would make it to USA."

Mark and Joyce were grateful for the hospitality and love they received during their visit. They felt welcomed and supported as colleagues and collaborators. Mark emphasized that the partnership's work has made a huge difference in Uganda: "Our vision is to make sure that palliative care reaches everybody in our country... Unlike other partnerships of Global Partners in Care, ours is a partnership with an entire country. You here are the greatest friends of Uganda as far as palliative care is concerned. Because we are the guys responsible for working with the Ministry of Health to take palliative care to every corner of Uganda."

In addition to strengthening of the partnership, raising awareness and support was central to the exchange visit. Other achievements included advancing research collaborations, pursuing learning

opportunities and strengthening engagement with CHC/HF staff and members of our community. Mark and Joyce visited Saint Joseph Regional Medical Center, LOGAN Community Resources, A Rosie Place, Indiana University South Bend and University of Notre Dame, among others. As the partnership grows, engaging other stakeholders adds value to partnership activities and helps achieve long-term and sustainable outcomes.

The Road to Hope (RTH) program is a shared program that touches many in our community. Ten years into the program, we support more than 60 vulnerable children who were caregivers for their dying parents with education and psychosocial support to help them grow into happy and productive members of society. During this visit, we held a strategic planning meeting for the program. Much has changed since we started, and we want to ensure the program, which is central to PCAU's work, is relevant and impactful. PCAU's new strategic plan 2022 - 2026 recognizes the RTH program as a significant part of their advocacy objective since the program

connects PCAU with the grassroots community. In the World Health Organization's new conceptual developmental model for palliative care delivery, RTH is PCAU's program that fits within the building block, "empowering people and communities."

To express their gratitude, PCAU gifted several handcrafted wall hangings depicting scenes of homesteads in Uganda. Mark expressed PCAU's hope that the gifts will serve as reminders of the impact the partnership has had on people and communities in Uganda. Mark also conveyed gratitude on behalf of all staff of PCAU, board members and members of PCAU. He shared that "for every little bit of success that we count for palliative care in Uganda, Center for Hospice Care has a share. It's this friendship and partnership that motivates us."

Honoring Choices Indiana – North Central Receives Health Issues and Challenges Grant

Honoring Choices® Indiana – North Central (HCI-NC), an affiliate of the Hospice Foundation, was formed to advance the idea that everyone in our service area should receive care that honors their personal values and goals in catastrophic situations or at the end of life. HCI-NC recently received a Health Issues and Challenges Grant from the Indiana Department of Health to help build community outreach and facilitation programs to assure that people in traditionally underserved communities have access to advance care planning programs.

This grant aligns with HCI-NC's mission of promoting and sustaining advance care planning to ensure that every adult's future health care

preferences are discussed, documented and honored. The COVID-19 pandemic highlighted why advance care planning is critical for all adults. During the pandemic, patients – many of whom had underlying chronic conditions like cancer, diabetes, heart conditions and COPD – were often unable to communicate their care preferences. In addition, heart conditions, cancer and diabetes are among the top 10 causes of death in the US. Certified advance care planning facilitators, like those trained by HCI-NC, can engage community members who have been diagnosed with one or more of these conditions to discuss and document their care preferences. Studies have shown that integrating advance care planning

into community health programs can improve the quality of conversations about health care choices.

To better reach underserved communities, best practices include ensuring programs are developed with leaders in these communities which helps the programs become both self-governed and self-sustaining in the long term. The Healthy Issues and Challenges Grant will help fund community focus-groups, outreach activities, facilitator training (including bilingual facilitators) and ongoing support for these facilitators such as resource materials and ongoing training updates in both St. Joseph and Elkhart counties.



Inaugural Circle of Caring Award Dinner Honors Tim Portolese and Dr. Bruce Newswanger

Warmer than normal temperatures in Elkhart, IN on the evening of November 2 added to the upbeat feeling at the Lerner Theater's Crystal Ballroom as over 330 people gathered for the Hospice Foundation's first Circle of Caring Award Dinner. Not only did it mark the inaugural dinner which recognized Tim Portolese and Dr. Bruce Newswanger, it also became the largest fundraising event in the history of Center for Hospice Care and Hospice Foundation! Between sponsorships, ticket sales, the live auction and donations, the event raised over \$540,000. The Circle of Caring Award was created to honor members of the Elkhart community who demonstrate civic and charitable stewardship that improves the quality of living in communities served by Center for Hospice Care (CHC). Tim and Bruce were the unanimous choice for the first honorees. Their lives have exemplified CHC's mission to improve the quality of living.

That mission was also reflected in the event theme, "Living Life to The Fullest." Tim, who has

battled personal health issues, has been a champion fundraiser for the Elkhart Humane Society as well as CHC and many other area organizations. Bruce works tirelessly as an emergency room physician, making sure that each of his patients receives the personal care they deserve. Tim's ardent support of CHC began in 2014 as he began serving on its board of directors. He joined the campaign cabinet of "Cornerstones for Living: The Crossroads Campaign," CHC's most successful fundraising campaign to date. As an emergency room physician and current Elkhart General Hospital board member, Bruce joins Tim as a strong advocate of CHC's mission.

"Bruce and I were humbled by being asked to be the first Circle of Caring Award honorees, and we were humbled furthermore by the number of people who came from out of town to attend the event," Tim said.

"I think the event went over incredibly well especially for an event in its inaugural year," Tim said. He described how both he and

Part two of a two-part story

Center for Hospice Care (CHC) has a long history in our community. We've come a long way from being the original hospice in the area under "Hospice of St. Joseph County" over 42 years ago. Our vision is "to be the premier hospice and palliative care organization for all end-of-life issues."

In fact, some of the breadth and depth of our organization surprises even the most seasoned of our staff, let alone the community that supports us. Yes, you may be familiar with our television ads, but we're so much more than that.

Center for Palliative Care

To review, to receive hospice care, a patient must have a prognosis of six months or less (should the disease takes its normal progression), it must be certified by two physicians, and the patient must be on board with focusing on comfort rather than curative care. Hospice can't change the disease, but we can be instrumental on making the most of each day and focusing on quality of life.

Patients can receive palliative care outside of the six month or less requirement and be receiving curative treatment. An example where palliative

care might be used is for a cancer patient who is receiving treatment that results in nausea and pain but is expected to recover. Our team will meet with the patient to identify goals and work alongside the referring physician. Currently, the Center for Palliative Care is only accepting stage 4 cancer or COPD patients.

Pediatric Hospice & Palliative Care

Terminal illness is always difficult, but when it involves children, it's magnified and radiates throughout a family and community.

Center for Hospice Care is unique, not only in the fact that we care for children, but we specialize in it. Children are unique in that they may receive concurrent care, which means they are able to receive both hospice and curative care at the same time. We've assembled a care team that focuses on the unique needs of children and their families.

Beginning when we receive the referral, our Pediatric Palliative Care team goes into action gathering the information and resources to make a family's experience the best it can be. Our Admission Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, Case Manager, Social Worker, and Chaplains are all trained in caring for children. Center for Hospice Care also has available assigned rooms at our Ernestine M. Raclin House designated for pediatrics.

Perinatal Palliative Care

Perinatal palliative care is compassionate support for parents and families who find out during pregnancy

that their baby has a potentially life-limiting condition. Our holistic care focuses on the needs of the family. This support is provided from the time of diagnosis throughout the baby's life. Perinatal palliative care helps parents embrace whatever time they have with their child and makes it meaningful, memorable, and family-focused with the support of an entire CHC Care Team.

Center for Education & Advance Care Planning

If you should become unable to speak for yourself, how will you ensure that your wishes are known and followed?

Advance care planning is the process that allows you to make your end-of-life choices known. These plans provide direction to healthcare providers when you can't make or communicate your wishes.

It's also important to discuss your wishes with your loved ones, especially the people you designate as your healthcare proxy. Making sure they understand your wishes will help guide any decisions they have to make in the future. Don't postpone discussing and making decisions until a crisis occurs. Advance care planning can help you and your loved ones avoid the stress of making uninformed decisions in such difficult situations.
